The site will be accessed by eight schools. Umuwa is the centrally located administrative centre for the APY Lands, and provides a destination for young Anangu that is central, on independent land, and provides for training in dedicated weekly blocks of time. It will involve students travelling to Umuwa from their home community to undertake specific industry vocational training. Accommodation at Umuwa for students attending the facility will be provided by the schools and the community. The project will address skills shortages in the traditional trades of Agriculture, Carpenter and Joiner, Cook, Metal Fabricator, Motor Mechanic, Pastry Cook, Tiler and Landscape Gardener.
