The fact that Mawson Lakes is the only University Campus this side of the Adelaide City Centre, and the number of degrees being offered there, really reduces the study options for people. Travelling to the Uni. of S.A. campuses, and to the Adelaide University, and, also to the Flinders University adds another degree of difficulty. Financial support is also required as the northern suburbs are home to lower income earners, and more people on government support, so the costs involved with tertiary study also disadvantage the northern suburbs communities. Child support is also required, and need to be incorporated in the design of any tertiary hub. And, the main barrier is political will. When votes are required our political masters suddenly become extremely interested in our views. That interest wanes once the election is won, until, once again, the electorate needs to be galvanised to vote for your political party. How about actually DOING something, instead of just paying it lip service? The political will to change the status quo is missing. Look at all of those Royal Commissions - just one way of pretending there is hope for a change for the better and that people are actually being listened to. Is this survey serious, or is it just yet another pretence, for something that will never happen. I hope that I am wrong and that this is a serious intent. I am old enough to be quite cynical about the possibility of a Tertiary Hub, including a University campus, as well as a TAFE, and a child care centre, ever actually happening. Please, prove me wrong.

Q3

It is about time governments, both at state and federal level, recognised that just because people live in the Northern suburbs, it does not mean that they are unwilling, or unable, to study at a tertiary level. The distances required to be travelled, sometimes after a full day of work, in order to access Tertiary study, either in the City, at Magill, in the City, or down South at Flinders University, is yet another added complication, to those who wish to further their studies and gain a better future for themselves and their families.

A holistic approach is required. Not just a University, but a TAFE, and Child Care centers so that parents can return to study after having their child/children, and, yes, this means an emphasis on female students and the support they need to return to tertiary education. It also needs to be recognised that not everyone wants a degree, but that they may want to qualify as plumbers, or electricians. There are more paths to prosperity than through a University education.

Are there any other measures you believe the Government should focus on regarding higher education?

The main question is, of course, why was the Uni. of S.A. campus at Salisbury closed in the first place, and the land sold off to private developers, and, if a new Uni. is set up out here, what is to stop that happening again? The political will blows hot and cold depending upon who is in power at the time. Taking a view longer than the three years between elections would be a step in the right direction. Let's try having a 20 year plan to better a community and the prospects of improvement for its people. Let's have action rather than lip service. Let's stop 'pork barrelling' areas that are not voting for Labor and actually improve the areas where the majority of Labor voters live. Let's stop taking the Labor 'faithful' for granted and try to upskill their education rather than use them as factory fodder. Also HECS, or whatever the Higher Education Contribution Scheme is called these days, needs to be subsidised for those people who want to study but who are low income earners, or on government support. Indexing the cost of degrees etc is turning people off of further education and study, as they are afraid they may never be able to repay the debts that they incur by doing further study under the current fees being charged.

1.5. Critical First steps to be taken

2.3.1.3 An end to the 50% Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP)/HECS-HELP Loss Threshold

The Job Ready Graduates package only seeks to further entrench inter-generational poverty. Ceasing the 50% pass rate rule is a big step in preventing further harm from being done by the Job Ready Graduates measures.

A high number of students who fail over 50% of subjects within their first year of university do so not because they are not intelligent or don't have the intellectual ability to be at university but because of other factors often, outside of their control. For example a high number of students who appeal preclusion from university have experienced homelessness, extreme poverty, the death of a relative, domestic violence or a range of other complex financial and personal issues. These people are often those who would not otherwise be able to afford university if it were not for the HECS-HELP system, meaning that when this is taken away from them because of circumstances outside of their control, it only seeks to further entrench disadvantage. Spence has some of the highest rates of power and domestic violence in Australia, meaning that these rules disproportionately effect people living in the Northern Suburbs. If we are serious about ending intergenerational poverty we must give people in Spence every chance of succeeding rather than ripping opportunities away from them.

Study Hubs and Regional University Centres

The northern suburbs have some of the lowest participation rates in universities in the country. If you look at the traditional sandstone universities like the University of Adelaide, participation is even lower. This low participation rate is exacerbated by a range of barriers but one which is easily addressed is access.

While the majority of localities in the electorate of Spence would not be deemed as being rural, as the interim report correctly stipulates, lack of access is not confined to regional areas. People in the electorate of Spence face some of the greatest barriers to education in the country. Having a dedicated place to study with access to resources and purpose-built equipment assists in breaking down access barriers.

Whether this is being able to remove yourself from an unsafe or unfit environment for study, access the technology required for courses or simply save much needed time and money, having an easily identifiable study hub in Spence would be of great benefit to the community.

A key consideration for the electorate of Spence is that many of the students who come from the area are first in family and at times are not supported by those around them. There is still a high prevalence traditional working-class families associating snobbery and elitism with seeking a university education that acts as an additional barrier to many young people.

One group of students in Spence which is not talked enough about is people who are non-school-leavers. People who may be anywhere between 30 and 70 years of age who choose to go to university. At the University of South Australia a high number of our online students are parents with young children or carers who cant afford to give up the time to travel into the CBD. Having closely located study hubs gives these people access to facilities that they otherwise would not have access to. Where someone is a parent or carer they have small windows in which they can study quietly or undertake exams in a private space, study hubs will be instrumental in taking away the barriers they face.

2.2.4 Supporting students to undertake placements

Some of the largest industries in Spence centre around the Healthcare and NDIS service provision. These are areas in which a large number of students in the electorate choose to study university level qualifications. These fields are often studied by some of the lowest SES students in Spence yet have some of the strictest and most intensive placement/Work Integrated Learning (WIL) requirements of any course. In order to study in these degrees people will need to forego weeks of work and other responsibilities in order to meet the requirements to graduate.

Where students are doing work which would otherwise be done by paid professionals, this work should be remunerated. There is a huge discrepancy in the number of students who find paid placements and those who do them as voluntary work. There is a traditionalist view that it's part of learning and that students who want to be paid are simply 'entitled', though for many low-SES students (including single mums), there is no option to forego weeks upon weeks of income every year in order to complete your degree. These are critical industries and if we want to address the serious healthcare shortfalls we face, we need to prioritise making it as easy as possible for students from disadvantaged backgrounds to succeed.

Restructuring of HECS-HELP

The current structure of HECS-HELP fees undermines the original ideals behind the design of the scheme. It currently further entrenches poverty, be saddling people from low-SES backgrounds with insurmountable debt. The Job Ready Graduates package adjustments to the scheme saw a redistribution of funding which was supposed to represent easier access to courses that were

adjustments to the scheme saw a redistribution of funding which was supposed to represent easier access to courses that were deemed a national priority but instead has had a negligible effect on what people actually choose to study and increased many people's HECS debts. The redistribution of funding also does not truly represent national priorities. This funding model also means that some people are paying more for qualifications in sectors where it is a lot harder to gain a high enough income to pay off the debt. With HECS-HELP now being a consideration in ability to get a home loan, it is further impacting young people in Spence, especially in the middle of a housing crisis.

Exclusion from Government support payments

Students have been systematically locked out of access to Youth Allowance with the majority students who are school-leavers studying a full-time load completing studies at the age of twenty-one or twenty-two. Twenty-two is the age at which people are deemed as being independent for the purpose of gaining access to social security payments through Services Australia (<https://www.servicesaustralia.gov.au/dependent-or-independent-for-youth-allowance-student-or-australian-apprentice?context=43916>).

A report conducted in 2022 by the National Union of Students (NUS) in conjunction with the Foundation for Young Australians (FYA) outlines the challenging conditions that many low-SES students face when trying to get an education. Many students are resorting with extremely poor mental and physical health, are malnourished and have higher university drop-out and fail rates as a result of increased financial pressures. A high number of students from low-SES backgrounds, rural areas and without parental support find it extremely hard to afford basic necessities while studying a full-time load at University. (National Union of Students and Foundation for Young Australians, 'Locked out of Youth Allowance: Student Poverty + Centrelink in Australia', 2022 [changetheage.asn.au]). With some of the highest rates of poverty and Centrelink recipients right here in Spence changing the age of independence to the age of majority rather than the arbitrary age of 22, would greatly benefit those seeking to study in the electorate.

Enhancing and Empowering the Student Voice

Enhancing the Student Voice is key to ensuring that University is a comfortable place for people from non-traditional backgrounds. The principle of authentic student representation is that in any room where decisions are being made that effect students, a student should be in that room and part of making that decision. Universities, especially sandstone institutions are not always the most welcoming place for students from non-traditional backgrounds. Attending university can be a big culture shock, but to ensure that universities are contemporary and accommodate students from a range of backgrounds, student representation should be integrated throughout all that universities do. This form of representation goes beyond the normal student politic and recognises that everyday students can and should contribute to how their institution functions.
